She was past president of the Credit Women's Breakfast Club. She had run the Kankakee Historical Society Gift Shop and enjoyed collecting bits of history of the area. She was a former board member of St. Mary's Hospital and a former member of St. Teresa Catholic Church. Surviving are two nieces, Melissa (Tyler) Toune of Manteno, Melinda Dupuis of Elk Grove Village; and two great-nephews, Stephen and Jonathan. One brother, Donald, is deceased.
