Visitation for Everett E. Evans, 76, of Bonfield, will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Tuesday, with a 7:30 p.m. Bonfield Lions service, at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee, where services will be held at 11 a.m. Wednesday. The Revs. Dennis Settles and John Cross will officiate. Burial will be in Bonfield Cemetery. Mr. Evans was a barber teacher at Pontiac and Stateville Correctional facilities. He had also worked for the state of Illinois Highway Department and was a barber in Bonfield. He was born July 5, 1932, in Bonfield, the son of James and Irene Dumas Evans. He served in the U.S. Navy (1950-1954) on the USS George Clymer APA 27 and earned the Korean Service and China Service ribbons. He was a member of the Bonfield Lions, Good Sams Camping Club, Central Illinois Green Club and the Bonfield Senior Citizens. He was a lifelong member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church. He enjoyed camping, antique tractors, antique cars and wintering in Florida for the last 12 years. Surviving are his wife, the former Pearl Batdorf, of Bonfield, whom he married Oct. 3, 1953, at Sacred Heart Catholic Church, Goodrich; three sons and two daughters-in-law, Eugene and Cindy Evans, Steven Evans and special friend, Sally, all of Bonfield, Richard and Donna Evans of Kankakee; one daughter, Susan Evans-O'Hearen of Bonfield; eight grandchildren; one brother and sister-in-law, John Sr. and Nancy Evans of Bonfield; and one brother-in-law, David and Karen Batdorf of

Bonfield.
