Visitation for Ezra F. Castongia, 83, of Kankakee, will be from 3 p.m. to 7 p.m. Wednesday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home in Bourbonnais. He died Monday (Dec. 15, 2008) at his residence. Mr. Castongia operated the Castongia John Deere in Morocco, Ind. He was also a real estate agent and retired in the '90s from Kankakee Federal Bank as a loan officer. He was born May 2, 1925, in Kentland, Ind., the son of Archie and Viola Arseneau Castongia. His wife, the former Veneda Giardina, whom he married May 3, 1947, at St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church, died Oct. 30, 2003. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army serving during World War II with the 47th Tank Battalion 14th Armored Division. He received the European, African, Middle Eastern Theater Ribbon with one Bronze Star and the Victory Medal. He was a member of St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church.
