Faith Friberg Beaupre, age 82, of Plymouth, IN, formerly of Bourbonnais, passed away on Saturday, December 20, 2025, at her daughter's home in Indiana. She was born July 16, 1943, to Elmer and Jeneva (Mastenbrook) Friberg in Chicago, IL. She married Jack R. Beaupre on September 8, 1962. Faith is survived by her daughters Susan Beaupre Lindholm of Middleburg, VA and Nancy Beaupre Waldschmidt (Dr. Frederick Waldschmidt) formerly of Bourbonnais, IL; her grandsons, Thomas J. Waldschmidt (Hannah) of Granger IN, Jack A. Waldschmidt (Caitlyn) Fort Wayne IN, Harrison B. Lindholm (Paola) of Vienna, Austria. Her great grandchildren Phoebe, Lily, Charlotte, and Lola. Faith attended Monmouth College and DePaul University. She modeled in Chicago and locally. Faith worked at the Bank of Bourbonnais and the law office of Jack Beaupre. She was known as "Miss Manners" in the community because of the years teaching local children etiquette and table manners for area park districts.

Faith was a parishioner at Maternity BVM Catholic church, and was part of the

She was a member of Kankakee Needleworkers Guild, Book Clubs, Gourmet Club, and Quadrille. Faith enjoyed playing Bridge, Mahjong, and knitting and was an avid reader.
