Fayanne Horrell, 82, of Kankakee, died Monday (July 15, 2013) at her home, surrounded by her family. Cremation rites have been accorded. At Fayanne's request, there will be no visitation.

Private graveside services will be held at Abraham Lincoln National Cemetery in Elwood. The Rev. George Miller will officiate. Other volunteer efforts included Meals on Wheels for more than 12 years, the youth group at Asbury United Methodist Church, and reading tutoring for grade school youths. She was known for her loving heart, homemade pies and her ability to cook. She was adored by everyone that was involved in her life.
