Florence M. Bradecich, 95, of Kankakee, died Sunday (Nov. 23, 2008) at Provena St. Mary's Hospital. Visitation will be from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. Tuesday at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 11 a.m. Wednesday at St. Patrick Catholic Church.
