Florence McMullen -- Kankakee Florence B. McMullen, 91, of Kankakee, died Saturday (Sept. 29, 2007) at Provena Heritage Village. Surviving are one daughter and son-in-law, Dr. Kay and Mayor Don Green of Kankakee; two grandchildren, Steven Green of Grand Rapids, Mich., Susan Green and fianc James Lopez of Kankakee; one sister, Eleanor Sanders of Portland, Ore.; three sisters-in-law, Lula Douglas, Lola McMullen and Leona McMullen, all of Kankakee; and several nieces and nephews. Deceased are her parents; two brothers, Irvin and Roy Manssen;

and one sister, Elfreida Manssen Janssen.
