Frances A. Data, 92, of Bourbonnais, passed away Saturday (Oct. 6, 2012) at Provena St. Mary's Hospital.

Mrs. Data was a switchboard operator for a sheet metal company. She was born Nov. 29, 1919, in Racine, Wis., the daughter of Henry B. and Ann M. Carls Jacobs. She married Battista "John" Data on Sept. 29, 1973, in Kankakee. He preceded her in death Nov. 17, 1991. She was a volunteer for Provena St. Mary's Hospital in Kankakee and at Provena St. Mary's Cancer Center in Bourbonnais. She was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church in Bradley and the CCW.
