Visitation for Francis M. "Frank" O'Reilly, 74, of Kankakee, will be from 9 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. Wednesday at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee. A funeral Mass will follow at 11 a.m. at St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church, where he was a member. The Rev. Charles Wheeler will officiate. Burial will be in Assumption Cemetery, Ashkum. He died Friday (July 3, 2009) at his home. Mr. O'Reilly had been an accountant for Harry Topping, a comptroller at Riverside Medical Center, COO and CEO of St. Catherine Hospital, East Chicago, Ind., and in retirement he worked at Ginocchio Enterprises, Inc. He was born May 4, 1935, in Kankakee, the son of Donald and Sarah Raboin O'Reilly. He graduated from St. Joseph College, Rensselaer, Ind., with a Bachelor of Science degree in accounting and then from Governors State University with an MBS in administrative health care. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army serving in the Army Chemical Corps and was an avid baseball fan. Surviving are his wife, the former Margaret Frazier, whom he married May 2, 1964, at St. Martin of Tours Catholic Church; one son, Frank J. O'Reilly of Chicago; two daughters, Mary C. Martin of Kankakee, Katherine K. Hodak of Bourbonnais; two grandchildren; two sisters and brothers-in-law, Cheryl and Bill Gerritson of Kankakee, Pat and Larry Benoit of Hanover Park; one brother, Donald O'Reilly of Bourbonnais; and several nieces and nephews.
