Francis L. "Green Jeans" Richards, 87, of Bradley, died Tuesday (July 28, 2009) at Provena Our Lady of Victory. Visitation will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Thursday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Friday at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Bradley. Mr. Richards was a custodian and bus driver for Bradley-Bourbonnais Community High School for 22 years. He also worked at Kroehler Manufacturing. He served in the U.S. Army during World War II and was a member of the Bradley American Legion. He enjoyed walking. Surviving are his wife, the former Anna Krall, whom he married Nov. 3, 1945, at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Bradley; one son and daughter-in-law, James and Carol Richards of Bemidji, Minn.; one daughter and son-in-law, Barbara and Alan Clutter of Bradley; four grandchildren, Leah Richards, Marsha Peters, Mark Clutter and Pamela Maas; and six great-grandchildren, Allyson Peters, Brayden Peters, Paige Maas, Jamie Maas, Andrew Clutter and Emily Clutter.
