The angels came to take Francis "Bud" Francoeur, 81, home on Friday (Sept. 11, 2009), on his sister Odora's birthday who awaits him in heaven. Bud was born in Beaverville, the youngest of five to Meddie and Jeannette (Besse) Francoeur on Sept. 13, 1927. Bud was raised in Kankakee and was a lifelong member of St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church. Bud married Alice Branz, the love of his life, at St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church on Sept. 28, 1952. Bud was a member of the U.S. Air Force and stationed in Texas and Washington. He worked for Jaffe Men's Clothing, A.O. Smith, co-owned Mr. Bud's Restaurant with his wife, Alice; and was a car salesman with Ed McBroom's, Jerry Fox and Tom O'Brien Lincoln Mercury. Bud scheduled and drove auction trips for Napleton's Auto Werks. He also volunteered for The Salvation Army, Provena St. Mary's Hospital and Riverside Medical Center. He was a member of the Knights of Columbus.
