Frank Czerwinski -- Manteno Visitation for Frank J. Czerwinski, 86, of Manteno, formerly of Chicago, will be from 4-8 p.m. Monday at Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Manteno. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Tuesday at St. Joseph's Catholic Church, Manteno. Father Ed Grotovsky will officiate. Burial will be in Holy Sepulchre Cemetery in Worth. Mr. Czerwinski was a journeyman stone cutter and restaurateur, owner/operator of Club Allegro. He was born Sept. 15, 1919, in Chicago, the son of Stanley and Sophia Wojtas Czerwinski. He served during World War II, in the U.S. Army, achieving the rank of Sgt. Major. He was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church in Manteno and was secretary of the Journeyman Stone Cutters Union. Surviving are his wife, the former Elizabeth Spisak of Manteno, whom he married Oct. 25, 1942, in Chicago; one son and daughter-in-law, Bernard and Sylvia Czerwinski of Orland Park; four grandchildren, Bernard Jr. and Amy Czerwinski, Matthew Czerwinski, Frank Czerwinski and Frank Ponziano; four great-grandchildren; one niece, Christine Czerwinski; and one nephew, Edward Czerwinski. One daughter, Debra Ann Ponziano; one grandson, Anthony Ponziano; and one brother, Albert Czerwinski are deceased.
