



Frank "Ike" Einfeldt

March 28, 1922 - March 6, 2012

Frank D. "Ike" Einfeldt, 89, of Bradley, died peacefully at his home Tuesday (March 6, 2012). Visitation will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Friday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Saturday at St. Martin of Tours Catholic Church, Kankakee.

Burial will be in Mount Calvary Cemetery, Kankakee. Memorials may be made to Hospice of Kankakee Valley, Honor Flight or to St. Martin of Tours Catholic Church.

Mr. Einfeldt retired from Conrail Railroad after 41 years of service. He was born March 28, 1922, in Kankakee, the son of Frank A. and Anna A. Steinkuhler Einfeldt. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army, serving during World War II in the 1884th Aviation Engineer Battalion in the South Pacific, Marianas and Okinawa. He was a member of Kankakee American Legion Post 85, Kankakee VFW Post 2857, the Vintage Squadron and the National Federation of the Blind. He went on an Honor Flight in April 2009. He was an active member of St. Martin of Tours Catholic Church, where he served as a lector and Eucharistic minister. He enjoyed playing cards.

Surviving are his wife of 68 years, the former Anna M. Serafini, whom he married Dec. 26, 1943, at St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church, Kankakee; three sons and two daughters-in-law, Michael and Sandy Einfeldt, of Bellevue,

Wash., Craig Einfeldt, of Bradley, and Stephen and Cathy Einfeldt, of Bourbonnais; two daughters and sons-in-law, Pamela and Ronald Gean, of New Lenox, and Mary and Kenneth Jones, of Orland Park; 11 grandchildren and 10 great-grandchildren; one sister and brother-in-law, Roberta and Donald Foster, of Streator; and several nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his parents; one sister, Marcella Peterson; and one brother, Harold Einfeldt.
