



Frank Fecke

April 6, 1915 - October 24, 2010

Visitation for Frank J. Fecke, 95, of Herscher, formerly of Bonfield, will be from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. today at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee, where funeral services will be held at 10 a.m. Wednesday. The Rev. John Cross will officiate. Burial will be in Grand Prairie Cemetery in Bonfield. Memorials may be made to Hospice of Kankakee Valley. He died Sunday (Oct. 24, 2010) at Harvest View in Herscher. Mr. Fecke was a grain farmer. He was born April 6, 1915, at his farm home just west of Bonfield, the son of Ed J. and Rose Meier Fecke. Mr. Fecke was a lifetime member of the Grand Prairie United Methodist Church of rural Bonfield, having served on numerous church committees, and was a member of the choir. He was active in his community, having served as an officer and member of the Kankakee Service Co. (director and treasurer), Salina Fire District (trustee and treasurer), Union Hill Farmers Elevator (board president and director), State Bank of Herscher (board president and director), District 77 School Board (member and treasurer), and Salina Sportsmen's Club (secretary). He served as an active member of the Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Service (ASCS) committee for 25 years, the Kankakee County Farm Bureau and the Kankakee County Flying Farmers. Surviving are his wife, the former Luella Grob, of Herscher, whom he married June 17, 1937; one son and daughter-in-law, Gerald F. and Julia Fecke, of rural Bonfield; one daughter and two sons-in-law, Judy and Lee Graf, of Normal, Jerald Dau, of rural Bonfield; and eight grandchildren, 16 great-grandchildren and one great-great-

grandchild. Deceased are one daughter, Shirley Dau; one great-granddaughter, Mary Faith Sikes; his parents; and one brother, Floyd Fecke.

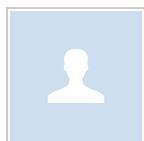
