Visitation for Fred E. He died Tuesday (Sept. 13, 2005) at Riverside Medical Center, Kankakee. Mr. Sage was a Herscher area farmer for over 60 years during which time he operated a dairy farm and custom corn shelling business. He was born April 4, 1921, in Pocahontas County, Iowa, the son of Edward and Jennie Ehmen Sage. He served in the U.S. Army during World War II with Company D, 119th Infantry, Old Hickory Division. He served in the Normandy Invasion. He was a member of the Illinois Farm Bureau, the Pure Milk Association, the American Legion and the Veterans of Foreign Wars. Surviving are his wife, the former Dorothy Gerberding, whom he married Feb. 1, 1946 at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Kankakee; one son and daughter-in-law, Michael and Kathryn Sage of Irwin; two daughters and one son-in-law, Kathy Sage and Karen and Mark Devine, all of Kankakee; one grandson, Thomas Sage of Valparaiso, Ind.; and one sister, Anna Roelfs of St. Joseph. Deceased are four infant children; one sister, Carrie Sage; and four brothers, John, George, Harvey and Raymond Sage.
