Frederick C. Hasemeyer, age 79, of Bradley passed away Thursday, March 8, 2018 at Presence St. Mary's Hospital in Kankakee. He was born December 12, 1938 in Kankakee, the son of Frederick & Annette Betourne Hasemeyer. Frederick married Joan Ahrens on September 14, 1963 at St. Martin of Tours Catholic Church in Kankakee.
