Visitation for Frederick "Fred" G. Lippold, 76, of Kankakee, will be from 3-7 p.m. today at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, West Kankakee, where services will be held at 11 a.m. Monday. Rev. He died Wednesday (March 9, 2005) at Riverside Medical Center. Mr. Lippold retired as a welder from A.O. Smith when it closed after 38 years of service. He was born June 21, 1928, in Livingston County, the son of Frederick E. and Alvina Krug Lippold. Surviving are his wife, the former Betty Hardesty, whom he married July 30, 1949, at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Kankakee; one son and daughter-in-law, Tom and Brenda Lippold of Aroma Park; one sister and brother-in-law, Vera and Gil Haire of Joliet; one grandson, Chris (Desi) Lippold of Kankakee; and several nieces and nephews. Four brothers, Harvey, Harold, Roy and Clarence; and four sisters, Margaret Walter, Louise Nielsen, Thelma Gillespie and Iohla Johnson, are deceased. Mr. Lippold served in the U.S. Marine Corps during the Korean Conflict and was a member of the Aroma Park American Legion. He was a member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church.
