Fredrick J. Mancuso, age 78, of Bourbonnais passed away Thursday, July 1, 2021 at AMITA St. Mary's Hospital in Kankakee. He was born January 6, 1943 in Kankakee, the son of Philip & Doris (Lade) Mancuso. Fred married Linda Walsh on August 22, 1970 at St. George Catholic Church.

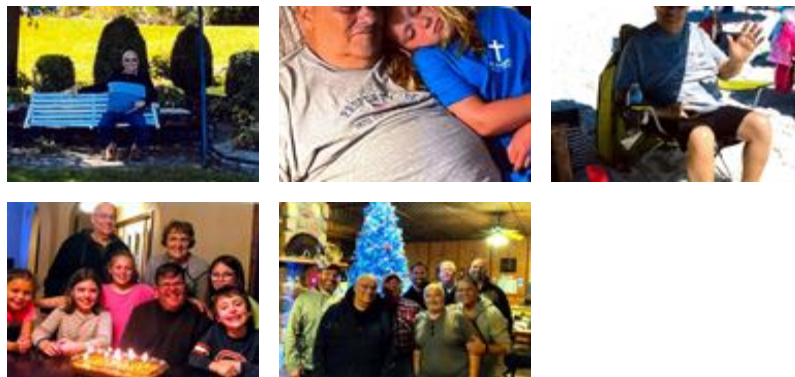

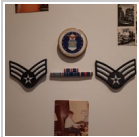
