Freeda Marie Legris, 86, passed away Wednesday morning, Nov. 11, 2009, in Bourbonnais. Visitation will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Friday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home in Bourbonnais. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 11 a.m. Saturday at Maternity BVM Catholic Church in Bourbonnais. Entombment will be held at Mound Grove Gardens Mausoleum.
