Frieda Hunger, of Bourbonnais, passed away on Thursday, June 19, 2014, at Presence St. Mary's Hospital. She was 76.

Frieda was born on Nov. 17, 1937, to parents to Sebastian and Franziska Hollweck in Lengenfeld, Germany. Frieda retired as a merchandiser for American Greetings after years of service but remained an active member of her community. Frieda was a longtime member of Maternity B.V.M. Catholic Church, where she participated for many years in the choir. She was a lady of the Moose, a member of DANK (German American National Congress), and a volunteer for the family support of the A Company 863rd Engineer Battalion while her husband was a member of the Army Reserve and after his retirement. In her pastime, Frieda was a participant of the Senior Monday bowling league at Brunswick Gala Lanes and a member of the Kankakee Area YMCA, where she loved to swim. Frieda was involved and generously donated to many charities. Frieda loved to travel, especially to visit her family in Germany. As well, she loved to cook, play cards with her euchre card club, enjoy her annual slumber party with her girlfriends and spend time with her family.
