Gabriele Kreutzer, age 93, of Kankakee, passed away Wednesday, March 24, 2021.

She was born February 8, 1928 in Würzburg, Germany, the daughter of Robert & Else Weilhart Oehrlein.

Gabriele married Dr. George W. Kreutzer on February 6, 1954 in Kankakee. He preceded her in death on March 10, 1988.

She retired from Kankakee School District III. Gabriele belonged to the Women of the Moose. She enjoyed cooking, sewing, painting, and gardening. She was a founding parishioner of St. Martin of Tours Catholic Church in Kankakee, where she served as a volunteer. She was also a lifetime member of the church choir and a former Woman of the Year.

Surviving are one son and daughter-in-law, Andrew & Delores Kreutzer of Kankakee; and two daughters and one son-in-law, Barbara & Paul Gabriel of Kankakee and Anita Kreutzer of Kankakee.

In addition to her husband, Gabriele is preceded in death by her parents; and one sister, Elfriede Oehrlein.
