Genevieve C. Dwyer, 89, of Bourbonnais, formerly of Deltona, Fla., died Thursday (June 5, 2008) at her daughter's home. Visitation will be from 10 a.m. Monday until the 11 a.m. funeral Mass at Maternity BVM Catholic Church in Bourbonnais. The Rev. James Michaletz will officiate. A memorial service will be held Aug. 25 in Florida. Burial will be in Deltona Memorial Gardens in Orange City, Fla. Mrs. Dwyer worked at the Health Department in New York for 20 years and later managed an apartment complex in California. She was born Aug. 10, 1918 in Syracuse, N.Y., the daughter of Edmund and Camille Theil Mahar. Her husband, James T. Dwyer, whom she married March 3, 1945, died in 1994. She was a member of Maternity BVM Catholic Church. In Florida, she volunteered for St. Vincent de Paul, and for a Right to Life organization. In her earlier years, she and her husband were members of a square dancing club. She was also an avid golfer. Surviving are two sons and daughters-in-law, Timothy and Atusuko Dwyer of Osaka, Japan, Kevin and Mary Dwyer of Bainbridge Island, Wash.; two daughters, Beverly Mulroe of Bourbonnais, Patricia and Christy Hartsell of Palo Alto, Calif.; 10 grandchildren and five great-grandchildren. Deceased are one son-in-law, Patrick Mulroe; four brothers and five sisters.
