Jake Guimond -- Kankakee George R. "Jake" Guimond, 86, of Kankakee, died Friday (Feb. 29, 2008) at the Miller Center. Visitation will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Monday at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Tuesday at St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church, where he was a member. The Rev. Charles Wheeler will officiate. Burial will be in Mt. Calvary Cemetery.
