Gerald E. "Jerry" Kirchman, age 84, of Bourbonnais passed away Saturday, March 16, 2019 at his home. He was born July 9, 1934 in Kankakee, the son of Edward A. & Anne Marie (Cieryca) Kirchman. Jerry married Lois Provost on July 14, 1956 at St. Teresa Catholic Church in Kankakee.

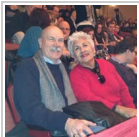
