



## Gerald "Jerry" Hamende

April 3, 1937 - January 21, 2010

Visitation for Gerald "Jerry" Hamende, 72, of Kankakee, will be from 2 p.m. to 6 p.m. Sunday at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Monday at St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church in Kankakee, where he was an active member. Burial will be in St. James Cemetery, Irwin. Memorials may be made to the American Heart Association, American Cancer Society, American Diabetes Foundation or for Masses. He died from a sudden illness Thursday (Jan. 21, 2010) in the emergency room at Riverside Medical Center. Mr. Hamende worked at Leiser Furniture in Herscher since he was 15 years old. He was born April 3, 1937, in Clifton, the son of Victor and Maude St. Germaine Hamende. He was a very loyal fan of the Chicago Bears and Chicago White Sox. He liked to travel and, first and foremost, adored his family.
