

## Germaine M. Hagan

August 6, 1937 - January 3, 2016

Germaine M. Hagan, age 78 of Bourbonnais died Sunday, January 3, 2016 at Presence St. Mary's Hospital. She was born August 6, 1937 in Kankakee, Illinois to Joseph and Mary Dauphin Gousset. Germaine married John W. Hagan, Jr. on August 29, 1959 at St. Rose Church in Kankakee, Illinois. He survives in Bourbonnais. 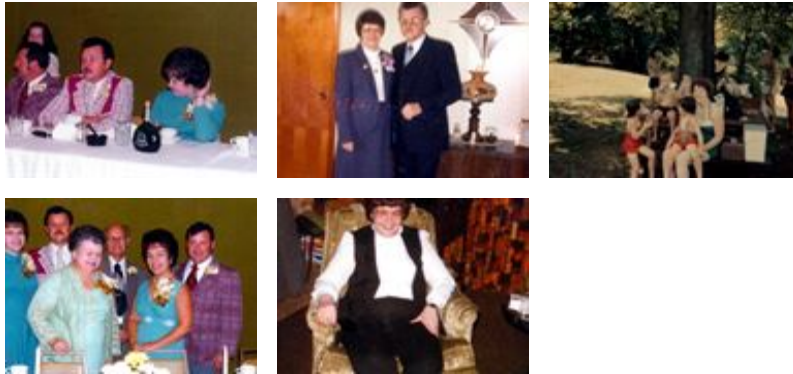

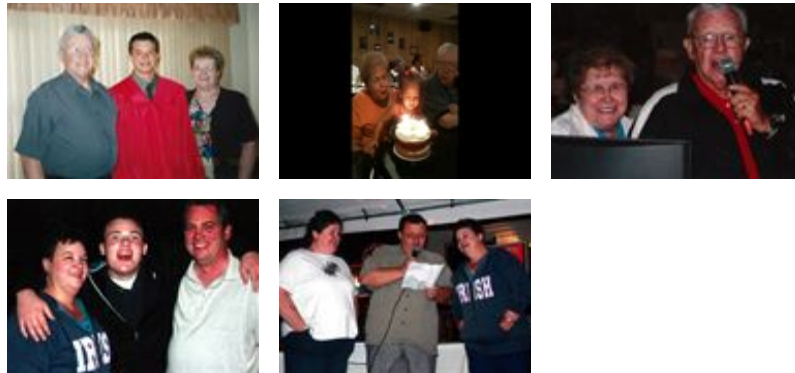

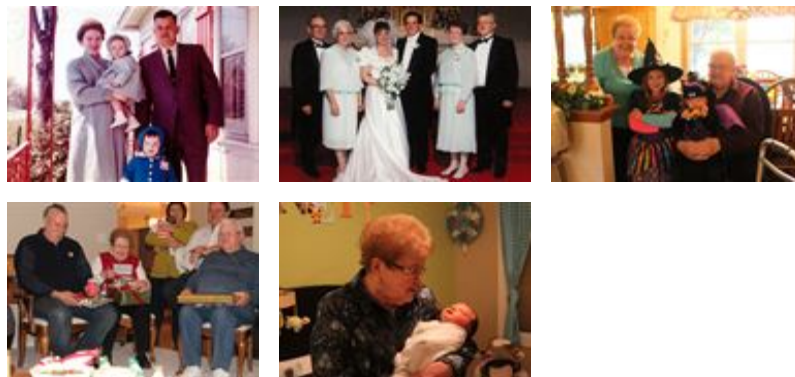
