Barbara Rewerts; and one brother-in-law, Phillip Poole.

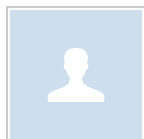

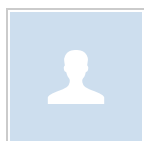

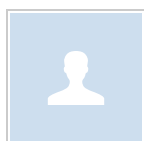
