Goldie Cleo Sapp of Kankakee, Illinois passed away on June 1st, 2018 at the age of 97. She was born in Bristol, Virginia on October 8th, 1920. Her parents were Lloyd and Florida Hudson Wolfe of Bristol. She survived six brothers and sisters: Howard, Carl, and Elgin Wolfe of Bristol; Mary Wolfe of Bristol; Lacy Wolfe of Kankakee, and John Hudson of Kankakee. Her parents died at an early age and she was raised by John and Emily Hudson of Kankakee. Goldie remained lifelong resident of Kankakee. In June, 1942 she married Kay Sapp and they were married for 59 years.
