Gregory Morse -- Bourbonnais Visitation for Gregory B. Morse, 60, of Bourbonnais, will be from 2 p.m. to 6 p.m. Sunday at Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais, where funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. Monday. The Rev. Randy VanFossan will officiate. Burial will be in All Saints Cemetery. Memorials may be made for his grandchildren's education. He died Thursday (Dec. 27, 2007) at Provena St. Mary's emergency room. Mr. Morse was a manager for Hunter-Douglas Window Fashions Inc. He was born March 2, 1947, in Kankakee, the son of Herbert and Novella Eastman Morse. He was a graduate of Bradley-Bourbonnais High School and a member of the Elks. He had coached in the Bradley-Bourbonnais Little League. He was an avid golfer and had two holes-in-one, enjoyed traveling and was a Cubs fan. Surviving are his wife, the former Sally Brown, whom he married Feb. 24, 1968, in Tinley Park; one daughter and son-in-law, Jennifer and Tom Roth of Alton; two grandchildren, Shelby and Jacob Roth; and one brother and sister-in-law, Al and Carol Morse of Bourbonnais. Deceased are one son, Joel; his parents; and two brothers, Neil Fahrow and Kent Rusher.

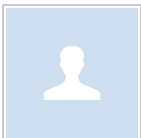
“ Sally and Family
