



## Gus Lorand

October 12, 1916 - March 20, 2006

Gus Lorand -- Kankakee Visitation for Gus J. Lorand, 89, of Kankakee, will be from 11 a.m.-1 p.m. Thursday at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee. Private graveside services will be held at Mound Grove Gardens. Memorials may be made to the Kankakee Public Library or to the donor's choice. He died Monday (March 20, 2006) at the Miller Center. Mr. Lorand was the retired owner/operator of Key City Provision, where he worked for 45 years. He was also the owner of Bradley Provision and Thrifty Car Wash. He was born Oct. 12, 1916, in Madison, the son of John and Oranea Lorand. His wife, the former Lula Dades, whom he married June 16, 1946, in Kankakee, died in June 1963. He attended Madison High School and Brown Business College in St. Louis, Mo. He was the chairman of the City of Kankakee Zoning Board of Appeals and a member of the Planning Commission. He served as president of the Order of AHEPA Chapter 345, Kankakee; vice president of the Greek Orthodox Church of Kankakee; and president of the Football Parents Club of Kankakee High School. He was invited by the president to attend the dedication of the Harry S. Truman Memorial in Athens, Greece in 1963. He served in World War II as a first sergeant of a medical unit attached to the 310th Bomb Wing, 5th Air Force in the South Pacific and was a member of Kankakee American Legion Post 85 and a longtime member of the Kankakee Valley Boat Club. Surviving are two sons and daughters-in-law, John and Joan Lorand of Yorba Linda, Calif., Nick and Renee Lorand of Bourbonnais; one daughter and son-in-law, Nina and Dr.

Steven Epstein of Kankakee; one sister and brother-in-law, Mary and Jerry Steele of Chesterfield, Mo.; and three grandchildren, Karen Epstein of Cincinnati, Ohio and Justin Lorand and Nicole Lorand, both of Bourbonnais. Deceased are his parents, one sister, Helen Dellas; and an infant brother, John.
