



## Harlan "Bud" Hiser

February 1, 1922 - January 10, 2010

Harlan "Bud" Hiser, 87, of Kankakee, died Sunday (Jan. 10, 2010) at the Miller Center. Visitation will be from 3 p.m. to 8 p.m. Thursday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais, where services will be held at 11 a.m. Friday. Burial will be in All Saints Cemetery, Bourbonnais. Memorials may be made to Youth for Christ, the Crisis Pregnancy Center, or to Hospice of Kankakee Valley. Mr. Hiser was a retired farmer and stationary engineer. He was born Feb. 1, 1922, in St. Anne, the son of William and Louise Pombert Hiser. His wife, the former Florene M. 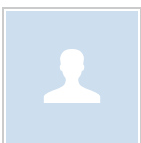
