December 20, 1938 - October 3, 2015

Harlen W. Windhorn, 76, of Bourbonnais, passed away Saturday (Oct. 3, 2015) at his home.

He was born Dec. 20, 1938, in Watseka, the son of Clarence and Adalgunda Bruens Windhorn. Harlen married Vivian Vadebunker on Dec. 4, 1960. She preceded him in death on April 11, 2006.

Harlen was the owner and operator of Windhorn Builders. He served in the Army National Guard.

He was a member of Our Savior Lutheran Church, and enjoyed traveling, fishing and hunting.

In addition to his wife, he was preceded in death by his parents; and one daughter, Christy Palm.

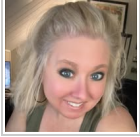

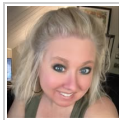
