Visitation for Harold A. Timm, 79, of Bradley, formerly of Kankakee, will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Friday at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Saturday at St. Martin of Tours Catholic Church, Kankakee. Burial will be in Sts. Mary and Joseph Cemetery, Chebanse.
