



## Harvey M. Longtin Jr.

Harvey M. Longtin Jr., age 63, of Bradley passed away, at his home, suddenly due to chronic illness on Monday, January 23, 2017. He was born September 12, 1953 in Kankakee, the son of Harvey and the late Iva Shane Longtin.

Harvey was a graduate of Bradley Bourbonnais Community High School in 1972, where he played football and track and field. He served 24 years in the Air Force.
