Helen LoBue -- Kankakee Visitation for Helen T. LoBue, 89, of Kankakee, will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Thursday at Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Friday at St. Patrick's Catholic Church in Kankakee. Burial will be in All Saints Cemetery, Bourbonnais. Memorials may be made to St. Patrick's Catholic Church, or to Aquinas Catholic Academy. She died Monday (July 23, 2007) at Joliet Area Community Hospice Home, following a brief illness. Mrs. LoBue was born Oct. 11, 1917, in Beaver Dam, Wis., the daughter of Carl and Theresa Garnis Girnis. Her husband, Vincent LoBue, whom she married June 26, 1936, in Chicago Heights, died in February 1984. She was a member of St. Patrick's Catholic Church, where she was a member of the Altar and Rosary Society and named Woman of the Year in 1977. She was a member of the Wake Committee and den mother; Sacristan; participated in Senior Citizens' Census; worked for pro-life and anti-abortion movements. She was a member of the Visiting Committee for the sick and homebound parishioners; cleaned, pressed and mended the altar boys' albs and cassocks for many years. She enjoyed gardening, reading, traveling and made a pilgrimage to Medjugorje. Surviving are five sons and four daughters-in-law, Donald and Linda LoBue of Springfield, Thomas and Rose LoBue of Carlinville, Paul and Linda LoBue of Madison, Wis., James LoBue and fiancée, Linda Goodman of Auburn, Calif., Edward and Helen LoBue of Oak Park; five daughters and sons-in-law, Nancy and Roger Sterbentz of West Fork, Ark., Theresa and Ed
