March 11, 1943 - January 12, 2005

Visitation for Helen Marie Regnier, 80, of St. Anne, will be from 4-8 p.m. Friday, with a 7 p.m. wake service, at St. Anne Catholic Church, where a funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Saturday. Rev. James Fanale will officiate. Burial will be in St. Anne's Church Cemetery. Memorials may be made to the St. Anne Catholic Church. Clancy-Gernon-Houk Funeral Home, St. Anne, is in charge of arrangements. She died Wednesday (Jan. 12, 2005) at Riverside Medical Center, Kankakee. Mrs. Regnier was a cafeteria manager for 17 years at St. Anne Grade School. She was born Jan. 22, 1924, in Beaverville, the daughter of Elmer and Loretta Bard Nourie. Surviving are her husband, Vernon "Spike" Regnier, of Watseka Healthcare Center, whom she married March 11, 1943, in Beaverville; two sons and daughters-in-law, Terry and Vicki Regnier of Watseka, Gary and Karen Regnier of Kankakee; one sister and two brothers-in-law, Elaine and Randy Arseneau of Beaverville, Lloyd (Pearl) Regnier of Sarasota, Fla.; two sisters-in-law, Delores Ahmann of Minneapolis, Minn., Inez Regnier of Beaverville; five grandchildren, Scott, Margaret, Tim, Johnathan and Jennifer Regnier; one great-granddaughter, Miranda Brook Regnier; and several nieces and nephews. One brother, Elmer Nourie Jr.; two sisters-in-law, Lucille Saindon, Parmella Laurent; and three brothers-in-law, Donald Regnier, Harry Laurent and Louie Saindon, are deceased. She was a member of St. Anne Catholic Church and the St. Anne Sodality. She was named Woman of the Year in 1999. Mrs. Regnier was also a member of the American Legion Auxiliary in St. Anne for 57 years and a

member of the Royal Neighbors.
