Helen E. Stowe Robinson, 85, of Bradley passed away on Wednesday, April 26, 2017 at Riverside Medical Center in Kankakee. She was born on May 27, 1931 in Kankakee, the daughter of Marshall and Flora (Smith) Stowe. Helen married Clarence J. Robinson on October 20, 1951 in Bradley. He preceded her in death on March 11, 2015.

Helen worked for Bear Brand Hosiery, then for Florence Stove Company (which later became Roper). 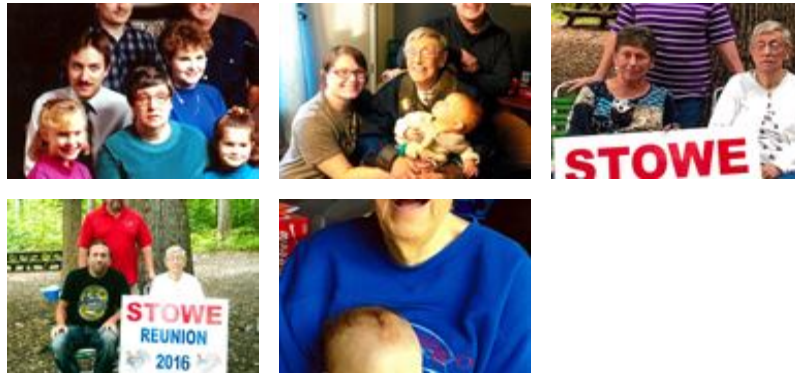
