Henry Mackin -- Batavia Henry James "Bud" Mackin, 89, of Batavia, formerly of Kankakee, died Monday (April 24, 2006) at Delmar Hospital, Geneva. Visitation will be from 10 a.m. Monday until the 11 a.m. celebration of the funeral Mass at St. Patrick's Catholic Church, Kankakee, where he was a member. Inurnment will be in Mt. Calvary Cemetery. Memorials may be made to St. Patrick's Catholic Church. Mr. Mackin and his brothers owned and managed manufacturing businesses (Mackin Corp.) in Momence and Hamtramck, Mich. and operated a farm in Grant Park. He served on the board of directors of Good Shepherd Manor, Momence; the American Red Cross, Kankakee; Contractor's Owners and Managers Corp. of Joliet; and Tackmer Corporation, Palo Alto, Calif. He was born Dec. 4, 1916, in Omaha, Neb., the son of Henry J and Elizabeth A. Koller Mackin. He was raised in Park Ridge and Kankakee. He attended St. Patrick's grade and high schools and graduated from the University of Notre Dame in Indiana. He was a member of the Knights of Columbus, the Holy Name Society at St. Patrick's Church, the National Education Association, the Kankakee Elks Lodge, the Elks Golf Club, the Kankakee Country Club and Plantation Country Club in Venice, Fla. He enjoyed golfing, fishing and hunting. Surviving are his wife, the former Florence M. Frechette, whom he married June 29, 1940, in Kankakee; two daughters and sons-in-law, Patricia and Daniel Hirschtick of Batavia, Pamela and Richard Drinkwine of Geneva; one son and two daughters-in-law, Michael and Janet Mackin of Ellicott City, Md., Jane Mackin of New Hampton, N.H.;

and seven grandchildren. Deceased are one son, Terrance Mackin; and two brothers, James and Robert Mackin.
