Holle Ann Tousignant, 49, of Kankakee, passed away peacefully Sunday (June 1, 2014) at the University of Chicago Medical Center after a long courageous battle of leukemia. Visitation will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Thursday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home in Bourbonnais. Additional visitation will be from 9 a.m. Friday until the 10 a.m. funeral services at College Church of the Nazarene North Campus, 897 W. 6000N Road, Bourbonnais. Cremation rites will follow the services.

Holle was born Oct. 20, 1964, in St. Anne, the daughter of Andrew and the late Shirley (nee Kremer) Pristach. She was employed by CSL Behring and was very proud of her 25 years of service.
