He was born Sept. 12, 1916, in Kankakee, the son of John D. and Abby Bineying Nesbitt. His first wife, the former Elaine Tetrault, whom he married in 1946, died in 1974. He later married the former Cora Kremer Jan. 10, 1981. She died May 28, 2003. He served in the U.S. Army during World War II. Surviving are two sons and one daughter-in-law, Scott Nesbitt, of Tampa, and David and Linda Nesbitt, of Tulsa, Okla.; and one sister, Shirley Goodell, of Momence. He was preceded in death by his parents and one brother, John Nesbitt.
