



## Hubert P. Fleischman

April 11, 1916 - December 4, 2014

Hubert P. Fleischman, 98, of Kankakee, passed away Thursday (Dec. 4, 2014) at River North in Bradley.

He was born in April 11, 1916, in Tuck, Ky., the son of Joseph and Mary Ann Fischer Fleischman. Hubert married Mary Donaghue on June 26, 1947, in Cabery.

He was retired from A.O. Smith. He was a volunteer for Disabled American Veterans (DAV); member of the Kankakee VFW; and also a member of the Knights of Columbus. He was a parishioner at St. Teresa Catholic Church in Kankakee. Hubert served in the U.S. Army during World War II, serving in the China, Burma and India campaign. He was a Chicago Cubs fan and enjoyed woodworking. He was known as the Aroma Park Batman because he made baseball bats for the kids. Hubert was also a school crossing guard.
