Hubert Remillard -- LimestoneHubert A. Remillard, 92, of Limestone, died Friday (June 22, 2007) at his home. Visitation will be from 5 p.m. to 8 p.m. today at Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Monday at St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church in Kankakee. Rev. Charles Wheeler will officiate.Burial will be in All Saints Cemetery in Bourbonnais. Memorials may be made to St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church, where he was a member; or Hospice of Kankakee Valley.Mr. Remillard retired in 1977 from General Foods after 37 years of service in the maintenance department and then worked part-time for Pickett Stone Co. He was born Jan. 6, 1915, in Salix, Iowa, the son of Alfred and Melvina Hubert Remillard. He served during World War II in the U.S. Army Air Force as crew chief on B-29 bombers in the 346th Bomb Group, 461st Squadron. He was a member of the Vintage Squadron. He served as treasurer of Local 70 American Federation Grain Millers for 19 years and was a charter member of the Kankakee Genealogical Society. He was a member of the Holy Name Society at St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church, and a volunteer for the Red Cross for 15 years. He served as institutional representative for Boy Scout troops at Limestone and St. Mary's Hospital Employer groups. He enjoyed traveling, gardening and working and making things in his workshop at home.Surviving are his wife, the former Jeanette Cahan, whom he married June 1, 1946, at St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church in Kankakee; one son, Paul Hubert Remillard of Rochelle; two daughters, Janet Remillard of

Rockford, Madonna Remillard of Coral Springs, Fla.; one sister and brother-in-law, Dolores and Louis Rivard of Bradley; three sisters-in-law and one brother-in-law, Doris Greene of Herscher, Evelyn and Mario Buono of Bourbonnais, Constance Cahan of Texas; and one brother-in-law and sister-in-law, Kenneth and Corinne Cahan of Ocean Springs, Miss. Deceased are one son, Charles; and one sister, Evelyn Linabarry.
