He was born Feb. 14, 1940, in Cleveland, Ohio, the son of Ignatius “Nasher” and Jean L. Minute Comella. He was a veteran of the U.S. Marines, serving during the Vietnam War. He was a member of the Kankakee Valley Boat Club and a former member of the Aroma Fire Protection District-Aroma Park. He enjoyed woodworking.
