Ivan Bossert -- Reddick Visitation for Ivan D. Bossert, 89, of Reddick, will be from 9 a.m. Monday until the 11 a.m. funeral service at Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee. The Rev. He died Thursday (Jan. 31, 2008) at Provena St. Mary's Hospital. Mr. Bossert was a lifelong farmer and also worked for several years with DeKalb Seed Dealer. He was born Nov. 6, 1918, in Reddick, the son of Charles M. and Ida Mae McLane Bossert. His first wife, the former F. Annette Elliott, whom he married Nov. 23, 1940, in Chebanse, died March 25, 2007. He was on the Essex Township Board for 25 years and was supervisor of Essex Township for 14 years. He was a member of the U.S. Department of Agriculture and the Farmer Elected Committee. He was a past treasurer at his church and a member of the Prince of Peace Delamation Illinois Council of Churches. He was on various farm organizations, was the Thomas E. Wilson Award 4-H County Live Stock Champion and 4-H leader. He enjoyed traveling and taking pictures. Surviving are his wife, the former Laimute Cinkuviene, whom he married July 4, 2007, in Reddick; three sons and daughters-in-law, Robert and Sharon Bossert of Essex, Rolland and Rosemary Bossert of Shorewood, Bruce and Gloria Bossert of Dwight; one daughter and son-in-law, Beth and Richard Holycross of Perrysville, Ind.; nine grandchildren and 11 great-grandchildren; one sister, Bonita Unz of Streator; one sister-in-law, Verna Bossert of Pontiac; and

several nieces and nephews. Deceased are one daughter-in-law, Betty Bossert; one granddaughter, Carmen Bossert; two brothers and one sister-in-law, Orland Bossert, Vernon and Alice Bossert; and one brother-in-law, Milton Unz.
