Visitation for Jack C. Ott, 69, of Bourbonnais, will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Thursday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home in Bourbonnais. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Friday at Maternity BVM Catholic Church in Bourbonnais. The Rev. Richard Pighini will officiate. Following the funeral Mass, cremation rites will be accorded. Memorials may be made to the American Cancer Society or to the National Kidney Foundation. He died Monday (Aug. 16, 2010) at Riverside Medical Center, Kankakee. Mr. Ott was a service manager for Roy Lang Oldsmobile. He then worked for Leo Kilbride as an insurance adjuster and later purchased the business. He retired in 2005. He was born Sept. 6, 1940, in Bradley, the son of Harold and Mary Carmon Ott. He served in the U.S. Army Reserves for six years. He was a member and past president of the Independent National Adjusters Association and was the current treasurer of the Turnberry Subdivision Homeowners Association. He was a fisherman and enjoyed working in the yard, especially flower gardening. Surviving are his wife, the former Margaret Brais, of Bourbonnais, whom he married Oct. 27, 1973; one son and daughter-in-law, Jim and Dawn Brewer, of Bourbonnais; three grandchildren, Rachel and Christopher Marnell, of Bourbonnais, Sara Lewis of Seattle, Wash., and Jessica Brewer of Bourbonnais; one great-grandson, Ryan Marnell of Bourbonnais; one sister, Carmen Gries of Chillicothe; one brother and four sisters-in-law, Terry and Barbara Ott, of Brea, Calif., Constance Pusateri of Beecher, Rose Greenhill of Manteno, and Lolita Broski of Bourbonnais; and
