Jacqueline J. "Jackie" Bauer, age 90, of Bourbonnais passed away Monday, March 12, 2018 at home. She was born January 29, 1928 in Bloomington, the only daughter of Frank & Gladys Ringer Hien. Jackie married Stanley J. Leek in 1947, a returning World War II Naval Veteran in Las Vegas. He had spent five years in the United States Navy, serving most of this time on submarines as a Torpedo man 1st class. He preceded her in death in 1975. In 1978, Jackie married Donald K. Bauer, a United States Army Veteran. He preceded her in death on December 6, 2009.

Jackie graduated from Lexington Community High School in 1945. Jackie worked in retail most of her working years. She worked at Jaffe Drug Store in Bradley as a pharmacy technician and floor manager in this store for over 50 years.

Surviving are two sons and two daughters-in-law, Michael (Chip) & Linda Leek and Gregory & Debi Leek of Bourbonnais; one brother and two sisters-in-law, Fran & Arnett Hein of Davis, CA and Nancy J.
