Visitation will be from 4-8 p.m. Tuesday at Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee, where services will be held at 11 a.m. Wednesday. Rev. Randy Caswell will officiate. Burial will be in Mound Grove Gardens. Memorials may be made for her son's education through the Jamie Heagle Fund at Peoples Bank. Mrs. Heagle was a teller at Peoples Bank and a Stampin Up Co. Demonstrator. She was born Jan. 13, 1978, in Kankakee, the daughter of Robert and Pamala Leggett Truesdell. She was a 1996 graduate of Herscher High School.
