James F. Mallaney, 88, of Limestone Township, died Sunday (Sept. 16, 2012) at his home. Visitation will be from 5 p.m. to 8 p.m. Wednesday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10:30 a.m. Thursday at Sacred Heart Catholic Church, Goodrich, where he was a member.
