It is with great sadness that the Taylor family announces that James H. Taylor passed away on November 9, 2024 in his home in Bourbonnais, IL.

He was born in Chicago, IL on April 29, 1948 to James H. Sr. and Geneva Taylor.

He was loved by his friends and family and will be greatly missed, especially by his wife, Marva J. Shipman Taylor.

James was the owner of Taylor Publications, founded in 1972, and the City News, which remains in print today.

He held memberships in numerous journalist's organizations, including the National Association of Black Journalists and the Illinois Press Association. He was also a member of the National Action Network. James was heavily involved in politics and maintained meaningful political relationships at the local and national levels. He had been interviewed by famed TV Show host Bill O'Reilly and worked with Former President, Barack Obama.

He also worked as a child abuse and neglect investigator in Kankakee County for 27 years.

Through his political and civic activities, he fought for freedoms throughout his adult life. He vigorously sought to better others' lives.

He is a member of the College Church of the Nazarene. James had many interests and loved to collect cars and motorcycles.

He is survived by his wife Marva Taylor; Stepchildren, Chris (Tina) Foulks and, Kelly (Danny) Lateano; sons, James Taylor, Jr. (Karla) and Michael Taylor

(Barbara) and their mother, Helen Taylor; numerous grandchildren; sisters, Deborah Thomas, Valerie Taylor, and Shirley Taylor; brothers, John (Yolanda) Taylor and Kenny Taylor (Lisa). He was preceded in death by his parents, James H. Taylor Sr. and Geneva Taylor, and brother-in-law, Tommy Thomas. 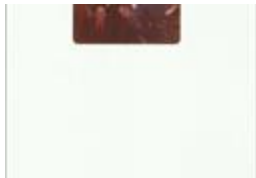
