Jane Ellen Boone, 79, of Kankakee, died Friday (Jan. 13, 2012) at Provena St. Mary's Hospital, Kankakee. Visitation will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Tuesday at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 11 a.m. Wednesday at St. Patrick Catholic Church, Kankakee. The Rev. John Peeters will officiate.

Burial will be in Mount Calvary Cemetery, Kankakee. Memorials may be made to Hospice of Kankakee Valley.

Mrs. Boone was a cook for Kankakee School District 111 for 24 years. She also worked for S&H Green Stamps Store and Piggly Wiggly. She was born May 17, 1932, in Momence, the daughter of Walter and Maude Keller Mitchell. She was a member of St. Patrick Catholic Church, where she volunteered for the prayer line.
